Brennan Dawson, vice president of the Tobacco Institute, the industry lobbying group, said on Face the Nation on March 27, 1994: "The industry does take the position that ... not only do they not add nicotine, but they don't manipulate nicotine. So Congress has been told formally by every cigarette manufacturer in the United States that this claim is without foundation."

We have a Nov. 21, 1970 report from Mill and Knowlton, Inc. from an observer at the American Cancer Society's first youth conference in 1962. *(It appears to come from T. I.)*

There is a collection of correspondence involving the National Association of Broadcasters with a cover letter on Tobacco Institute stationery that says it "has just come into our hands," signed Horace R. Kornegay, the president of the Tobacco Institute, dated April 28, 1978.
