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



Comments:

Alaska: Corporate contributions not permitted; ACLU will use funds for litigious activities.

California: Max. amt. \$5,000 per calendar year to political parties, \$500 per election for statewide races, \$250 per election for legislative races and \$500 per election for Board of Equalization candidates. No limits for recall elections. Major Donor Report.

Florida: Max. amt. \$500 per election per candidate for statewide office or retention of a Supreme Court Justice, Judge of district Court of Appeals and to a candidate for countywide office or to a candidate in any election conducted on less than a countywide basis, for legislative or multicounty office, for county court judge or circuit judge or to a political committee supporting or opposing one or more candidates. No limits for political parties. No reporting.

Georgia: Max. amt. \$5,000 per year for statewide candidates, \$2,000 in an election year for general assembly or public office that is not statewide and \$1,000 per year for all candidates in a non-election year.

Idaho: No max. amt. No reporting.

Missouri: Max. amt. \$1,025 for statewide candidates, \$500 for state senate candidates and \$250 for state representative candidates (all per election). The speaker's campaign fund is considered a statewide race since anyone can run for it. All per Rick Thompson at the Missouri Ethics Commission. No reporting.

Oregon: On February 6, 1997, the Oregon Supreme Court declared Ballot Measure 9 unconstitutional. No max. amt. No reporting.

South Dakota: FROM RJR PAC. No max. amt. FEC report.

Virginia: No max. amt. No reporting.

Washington: As of July 1997, max. amt. is \$550 per election for candidates running for state house and senate and up to \$1,100 per election for all other candidates for state office. Max. amt. for political committees is \$2,750. Contributions to state party's exempt accounts have no limits. (Max. amt. will be adjusted every two years to allow for inflation.) No report if contributions are made with general corp. funds, unless corp. gives more than \$10,000 in aggregate to State office candidates.
