Project CFM

Ten cartons of CARLTON cigarettes were fabricated on Thursday and coded CFM-16. This cigarette is the same as CFM-15 and was remade because our analysis indicated that the solids and nicotine were slightly above the specified figures on the label.

Model CFM-16 was also found to be high in solids and nicotine, so this cigarette will be remade today with filter rods and tipping paper known to be of good quality.
